

Position Available: Youth Staff for Ohio Valley Yearly Meeting (2)

General Summary: Youth Staff run the yearly meeting program for teens. The Youth Services Committee plans activities and provides support, while the Staff keep youth engaged in fun activities that promote development of their Quaker identity. We especially welcome applications from Friends with teaching or other direct experience working with middle schoolers and high schoolers.

Youth Staff report to the Youth Services Committee Chair.

Specific Duties:

- Participate with youth in social and learning activities during OVYM Annual Sessions, including a day-long river rafting trip.
- Guide youth in organizing and facilitating their own business meetings, including building consensus as they draft an epistle to share with the larger community.
- Support youth as individuals and in teams as they plan and rehearse variety show performances.

Minimum Qualification:

- A high school diploma
- At least one year of training or experience related to education or recreation

Preferred Qualifications:

- An associate or bachelor's degree in education or a related field
- Membership in a Friends Meeting within the Ohio Valley Yearly Meeting
- Teacher certification in Indiana, Kentucky, or Ohio
